State Budget

We knew coming into this legislative session that writing the state budget was going to be a challenge. When Comptroller Combs released her final numbers, the state was facing around a 27 billion dollar shortfall.



If you and I have had the chance to talk since the house leadership released the initial draft of the budget, then you have already heard me refer to the plan as a "shock and awe" budget. It is a first draft, and it will not be the version of the plan that the house passes later during the session.

Of course, one of the main areas of the budget we will need to address is education funding. When I talked with

members of the Mesquite Council of PTAs (pictured above), and in conversations with our local superintendents, I have expressed my commitment to correcting the current funding disparity that affects our local schools. Mesquite receives, on average, one of the lowest dollar amounts per pupil of any district in the Metroplex. I am currently working with the Equity Center and other members of the house to help craft a plan that makes sure districts that already do more with less are not disproportionately affected by the current shortfall.
