Another busy week...

This week began on Sunday afternoon when the members returned to Austin from our home districts to continue debating HB 1, the House Appropriations bill. After almost a full 24 hours of debate, the bill finally passed the House and headed to Conference Committee. Members from the House and Senate will now be selected to craft one final budget.

The speed picked up quickly on Monday morning as we started what will become common practice of hearing multiple bills in a day on the General Calendar. Tuesday brought about a Public Education Committee hearing where we heard about possible new solutions for school finance. And Wednesday saw a State Affairs Committee hearing that covered a large range of issues.

Tuesday also presented my first opportunity to lay out a bill to the body as a whole on the General calendar, as I passed HB 571, that I like to call the "Silt Bill", from the House to the Senate Chamber.

Thursday slowed down a bit, but we held a Public Education subcommittee hearing on bullying early in the morning and debated several large bills on the House floor that afternoon. Probably the best part of Thursday was the chance to join thirteen of my fellow Freshmen in presenting their first bills to the Chamber. They received a little hazing, but it was all in good fun.
