Free COVID-19 Testing

Every home in the U.S. is eligible to order 2 sets of 4 **free** at-home COVID-19 tests. Orders will usually ship in 7-12 days and will be delivered by USPS.

Order your tests now so you have them when you need them. Click the image or follow the link below to order your tests: https://www.covidtests.gov/

The tests available for order:

- Are rapid antigen at-home tests, not PCR
- Can be taken anywhere
- Provide results within 30 minutes (no lab drop-off required)
- Work whether or not you have COVID-19 symptoms
- Work whether or not you are up to date on your COVID-19 vaccines

METRO Climate Action Plan

This year, the METRO Board of Directors has adopted an agency-wide Climate Action Plan, "which charts a path to a more resilient and sustainable future." It is guided by the Federal Transit Administration's Sustainable Transit for a Healthy Planet Challenge, which aims to reduce U.S. greenhouse gas emissions by 50 percent or more by 2030.

As a part of their Climate Action Plan, METRO has purchased:

- 20 full-size electric buses (pictured to the right) and
- 10 paratransit vans.

Additionally, METRO will soon explore the use of vehicles powered by hydrogen fuel cell electric technology. METRO is committed to meeting a 100 percent zero-emissions bus replacement goal by 2030.

Texas Special Election - May 7th

Governor Greg Abbott <u>issued a proclamation</u> setting Saturday, May 7, 2022 as the special election day for two proposed constitutional amendments in Texas.

The League of Women Voters of Texas has prepared a Voters Guide for the 2022 Special Constitutional Amendments Election using the analyses <u>language from the Texas Legislative</u> Council.

What do I need in order to host an air monitor?

- An outdoor plug
- · Strong wifi connection (to upload air quality data)
- Be located in the 77081 Zipcode*

*Proximity to suspected pollution emitters will be taken into consideration. Not all interested parties will receive an air monitor.

AAH started the Community Air Monitoring Program in early 2021 to give communities more agency and information over and on their air quality.
