2014 Primary Election

Early voting for the 2014 Primary Election begins Tuesday, February 18, 2014, and runs through Friday, February 28, 2014. The Primary Election date is Tuesday, March 4, 2014.

The new Voter ID law is in effect and voters will be required to show one of the following approved forms of photo identification:

- Texas driver license issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
- Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS (**FREE OF CHARGE**)
- Texas personal identification card issued by DPS
- Texas concealed handgun license issued by DPS
- United States military certificate with photo
- United States citizenship certificate with photo
- United States passport

With the exception of the U.S. citizenship certificate, the identification must be current or have expired no more than 60 days at the time of voting.

To accommodate citizens, DPS is offering Saturday hours at select driver license offices to issue Election Identification Certificates (EIC) only. DPS will also be deploying mobile stations to various locations to ensure Texans have access to EICs.
