## Dear friends,

After redistricting lines were set in 2012, all 150 House Districts in Texas had roughly the same number of residents (the combined deviation of the most populous district and the least populous district from the ideal district population does not exceed 10 percent). House District 98, our district, has one of the highest voter turnouts in the state – in 2012 our vote total was #5 out of 150. After the end of early voting House District 98 leads the pack in Tarrant County with 29,076 votes, a full 6,000 votes more than the second highest district – and 23,000 votes more than the last place district! At the current pace, we could reach over 40% turnout overall. But that still means that most registered voters won't be participating.

I am preaching to the choir, I know. If you are reading this journal you have contacted our office in the past and you are most likely a voter. But the chances are high that half the adults you see before November 4th, won't be voting. In this newsletter, we include information to make it easier for you to vote – please share with your friends and neighbors!

One tool that I often use is the new Tarrant County Voter Lookup website: <https://gisit.tarrantcounty.com/VoterLookup/>. This website allows you to find your voting location and even download a sample ballot. As you go vote, please remember to bring your photo identification. While the courts have gone back and forth on this very recently, in this election you must bring acceptable identification.

Last month, I had the opportunity to meet with various groups in the area including the Grapevine-Colleyville Association of Retired School Employees, the Texas Society of Professional Engineers and residents interested in an update on road construction near John McCain/26. I also spoke to several local groups about the details of Proposition 1. We held our public testimony on the Lottery Commission in October. One interesting analysis that came from the meeting was that HD98 has one of the highest income per capita in the state and a low per capita purchase of lottery/scratch card tickets. That means that HD98 residents spend up to nine times less of their income in lottery tickets than residents elsewhere. The results of our study will be out next month and I will be sharing the details with you. In November, I will be focused on refining our legislative agenda for the next session – please let me know if there are critical items you believe that we should address in the upcoming 84th session.

Thank you for allowing me the privilege to serve you in the Texas House.

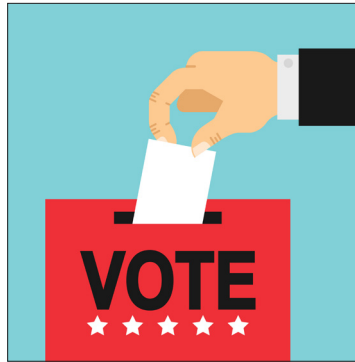
